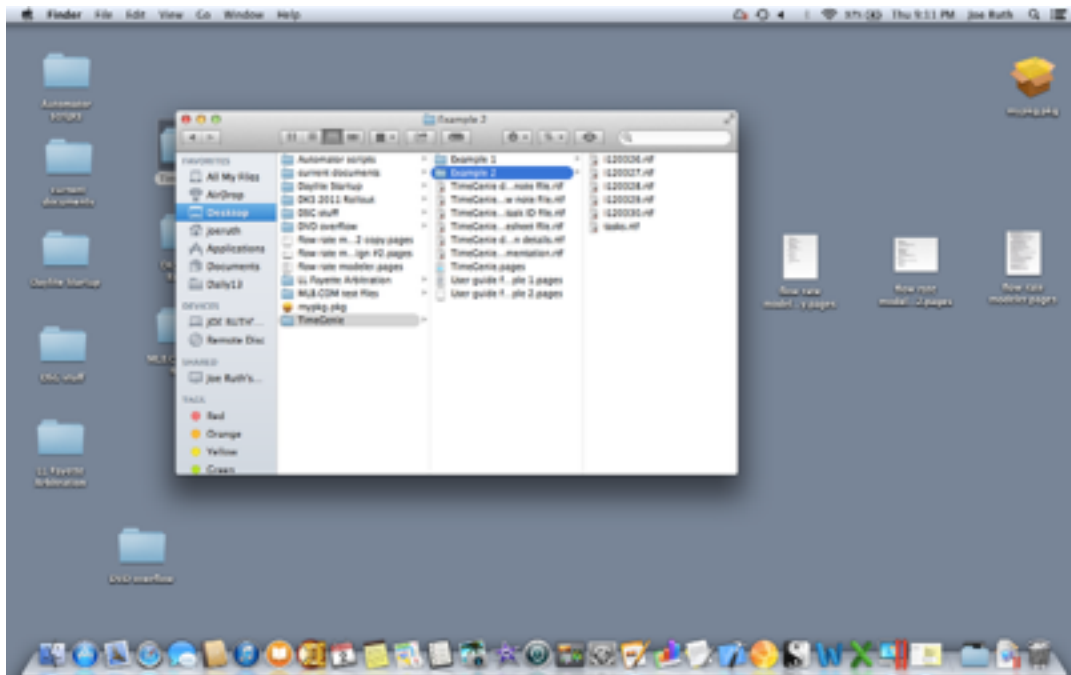
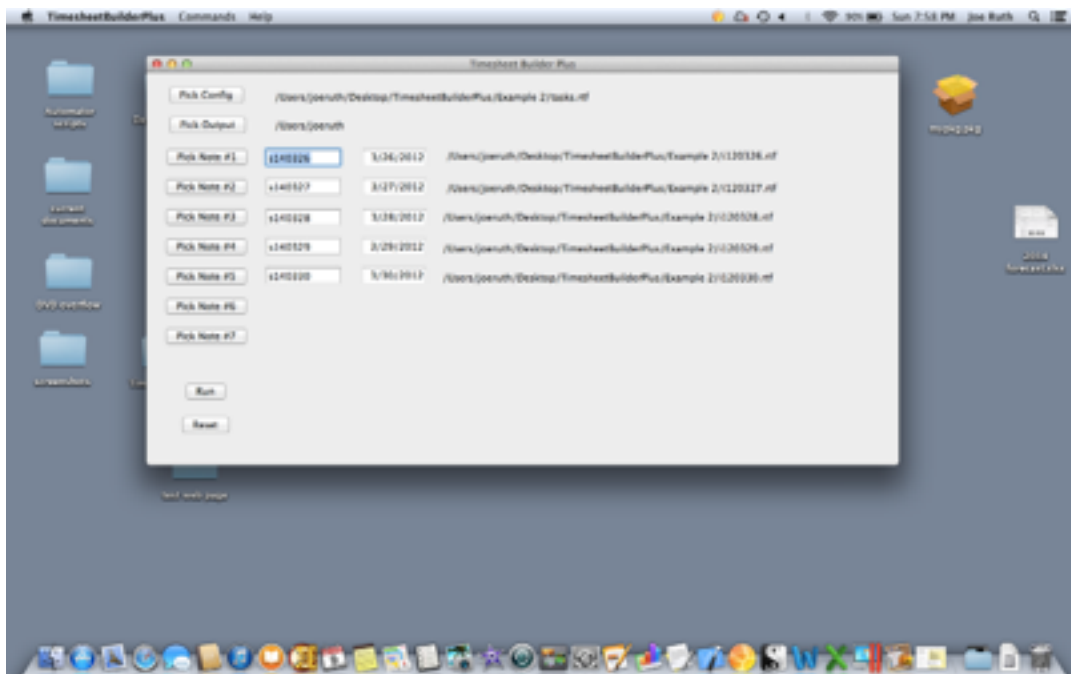


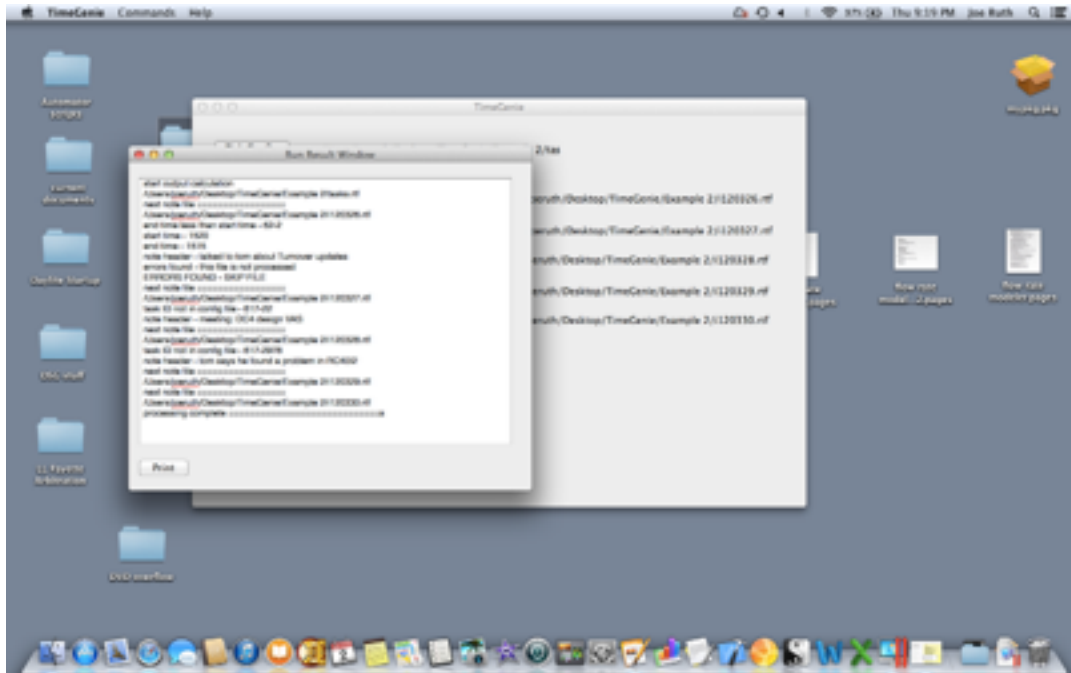
In this example, there were some input errors which were intentionally introduced into the note files. We'll see the errors and then review a few ways to repair them.



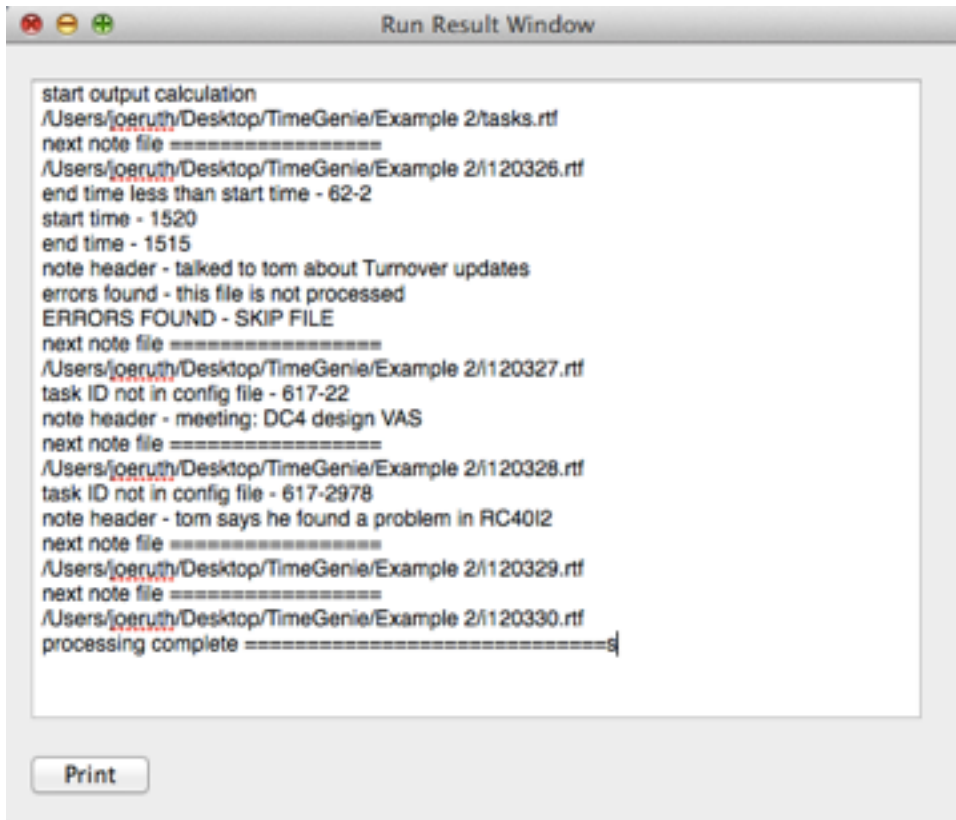
This screen display shows the second example set before any work has been performed. It's the same file names as the first example so we can jump right to pressing of the 'Run' button. This is the screen just prior to clicking on the 'Run' button.



After click on the 'Run' button, you can see by checking the output display scroll window, that some errors have been identified.

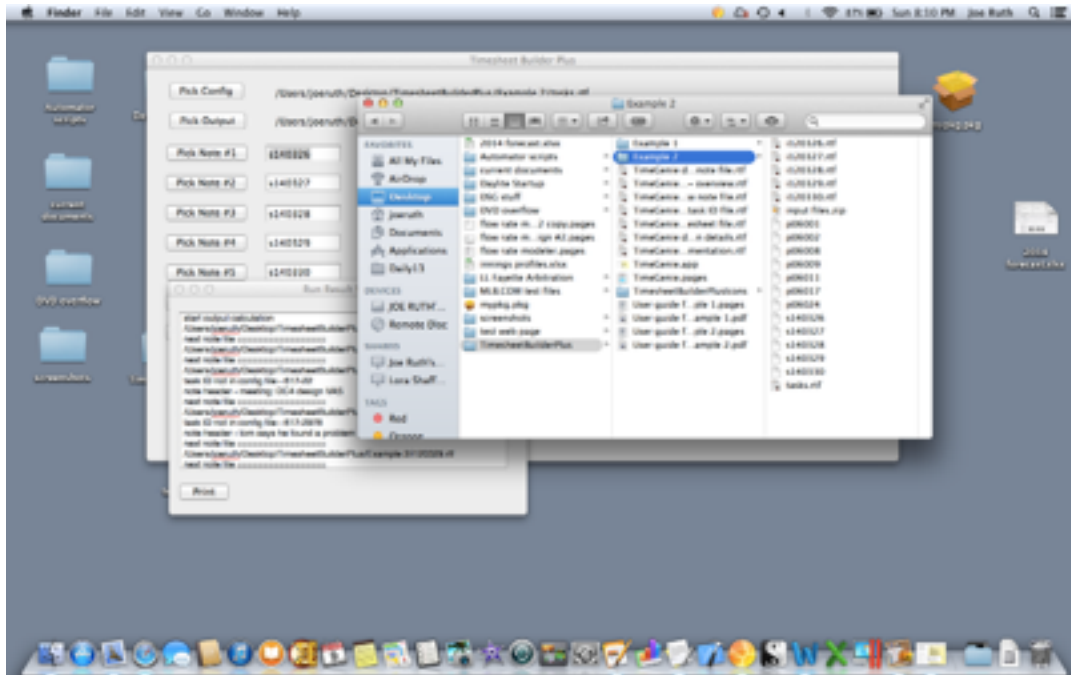


Here is a zoomed view of the output display scroll window.

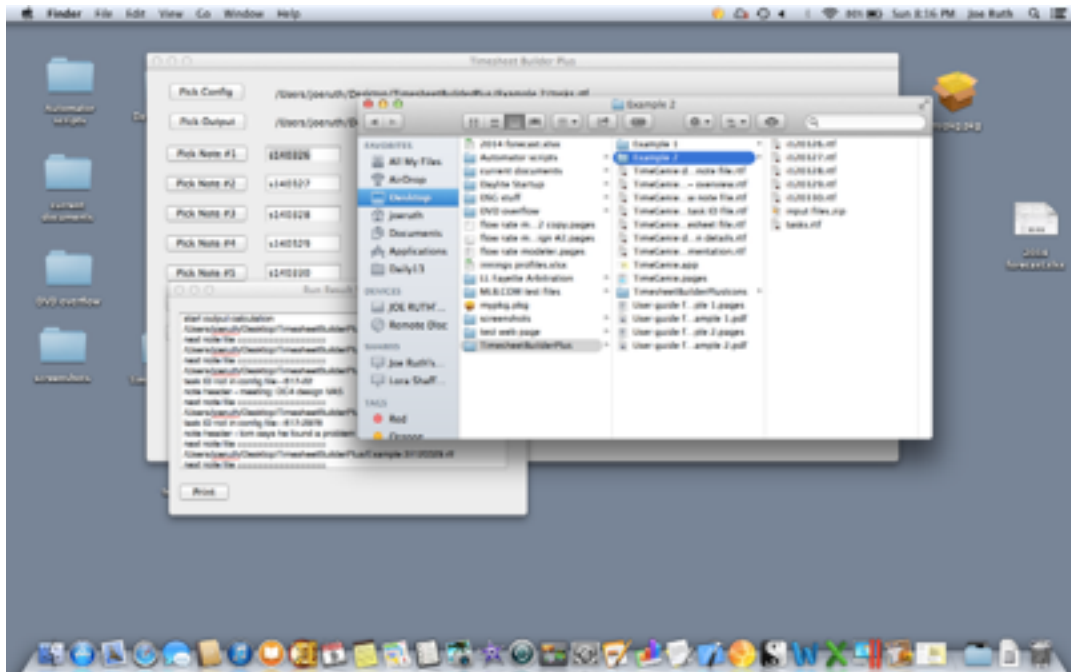


Looks like an error of some type was identified in several files. The FIRST thing to do is to press the 'Reset' button on the main screen to delete the output time and note files. You don't HAVE to do this but the note files will not be overwritten on the next run but added to instead.

Before hitting the 'Reset' button, the file directory looks like this...



Please note all of the note and timesheet files which are now in the directory. Pressing reset gets rid of all of them and gets you back to the original directory files.



There is no fanfare when the 'Reset' button is clicked but the files do disappear.

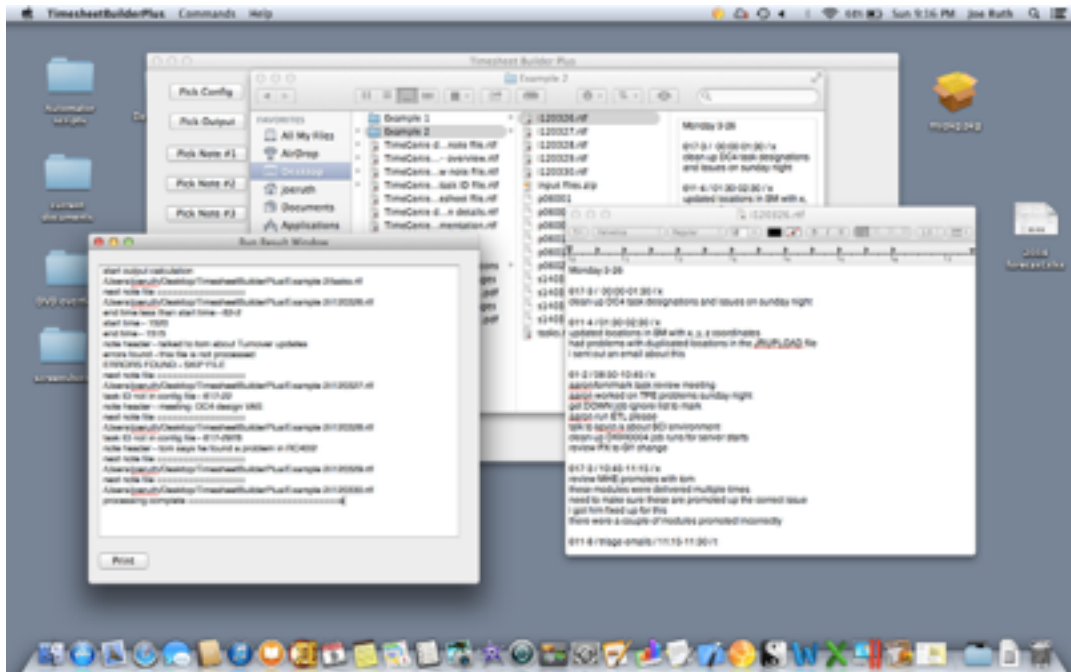
Getting back to the output window, the first error found was...

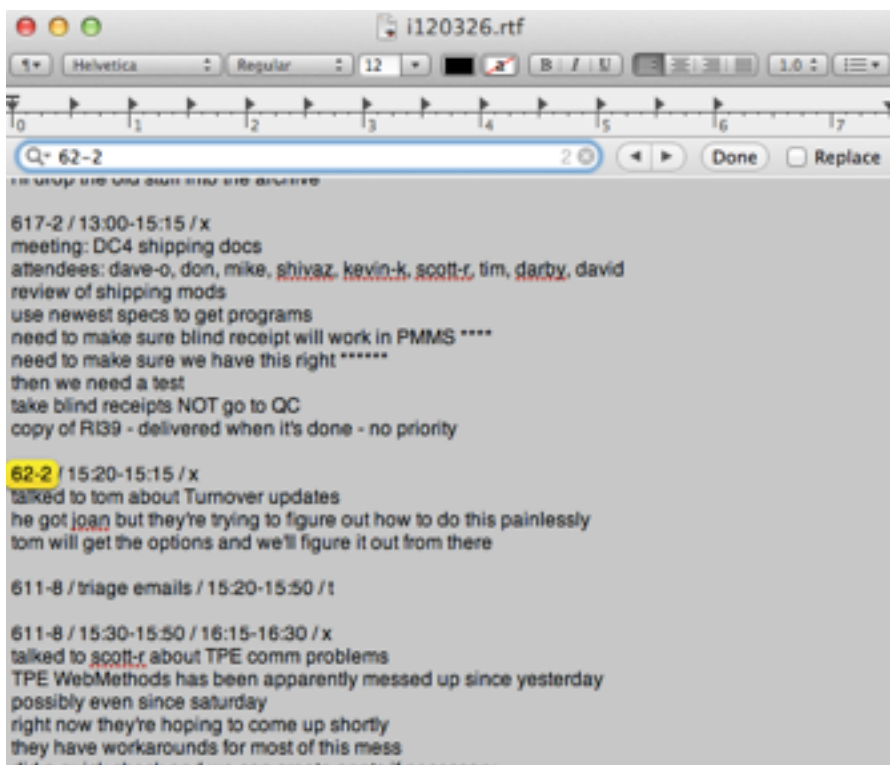

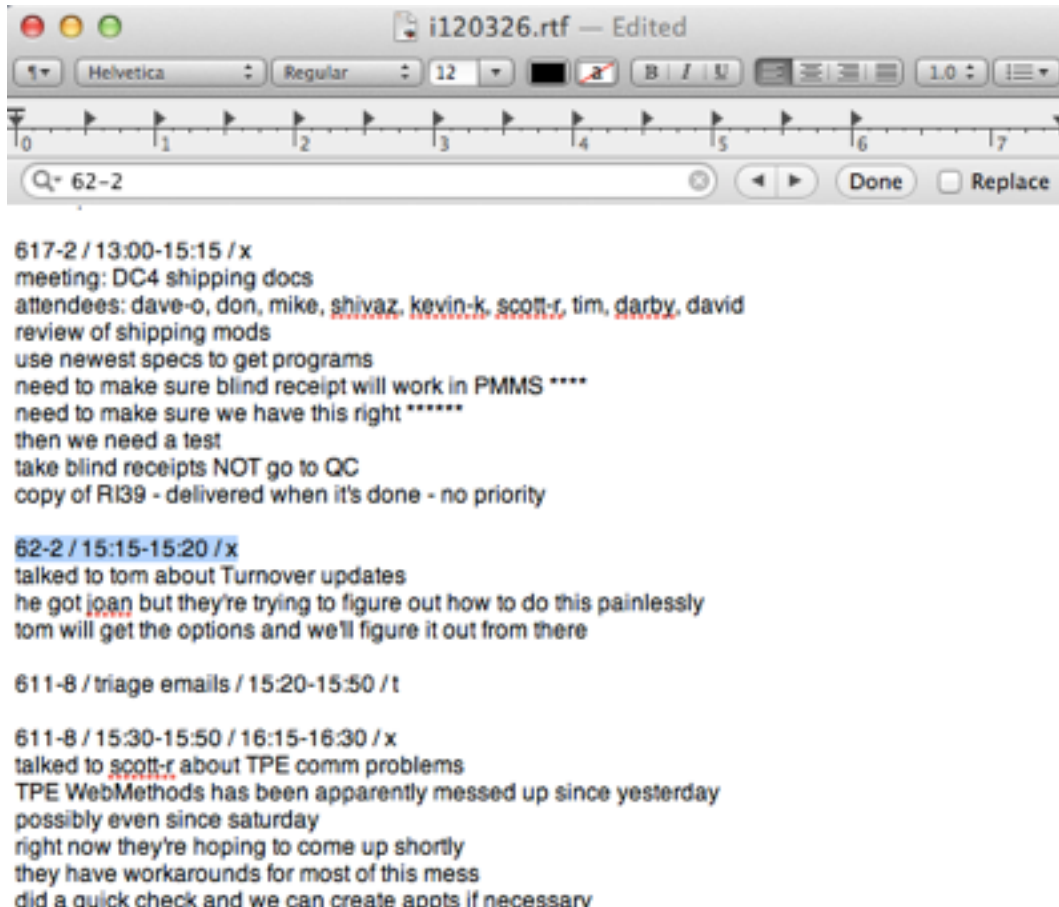
Use Finder and TextEdit to bring up the file and start searching around for the time or the first header of the note like or the Task ID. Anything will do as long as you find the problem.



In this instance, I used finder to get to the directory and double clicked on the file.



The error is that the 'start' time is before the 'end' time. The next step would be to correct the line that is in error. In this situation, the You could turn it into a note and just use one time entry or fix the time entries so that the start time is less than the ending time. We'll make the time change because it is probably what intended.



Make the change and that's pretty much that. Save the file and move on to the next error.

The next error is as follows:

```

note header - meeting: DC4 design VAS

This one is pretty simple. The task 22 is not under section 6-17 in the Task ID file. Looking at the chose Task ID file, we see the following entries in the 6-17 section...

We could either add a #22 line into the 6-17 section or change the original note files to no longer reference 617-22.

The last error is another missing task under the 68 section of the Task ID file. Add that in and everything is set for a rerun.

Make sure that the reset button is pressed once to make sure the output files are cleaned off and not added into again and rerun the process. Everything should be ok this time.
